


















Short distance view north along the local footpath, the historic coppicing of shrubs and trees has resulted in the observed tunnel effect. Views are heavily constrained by the adjacent planting with little or no awareness of the sky above or the adjoining woodland. The view is representative of those experienced by users of the footpath, within a managed area of woodland.



BINSTED WOODS



A middle distance view east and south east of gently undulating landform, comprising several arable fields with a backdrop of mature woodland (Ash Piece and Binsted Woods). The view is representative of sequential views experienced by users of Binsted Lane and nearby properties.

A narrow enclosed view, south west along Binsted Lane. The view is bounded by outgrown hedges and mature trees either side of the road that focuses the views creating a tunnel effect. This viewpoint is representative of users of Binsted Lane.

Mid to longer distance views revealed as the bridleway (Old Scotland Lane) emerges from the woodland at Pedlars Croft, the views are primarily to the south and south west. The gently rolling landform is a defining feature of this view with the focus of the view to the south framed by the rising landform to the west and south west. The view is representative of those users of the bridleway (Old Scotland Lane), those on horseback are likely to have slightly more elevated views.

Similarly to Viewpoint 4, this view is of the rolling landform revealed to the west as it gently rises, with woodland and hedges containing views eastwards and south, associated with fringes of Binsted Park. The view is representative of the users of the footpath that links the southern end of Ash Piece (woodland) with Binsted Lane.

View to the north east from St Mary's Church on Binsted Lane towards the SDNP. The view is composed of the simple rural scenes surrounding the Binsted. The quiet rural lane and managed hedges of the foreground give way to open undulating fields that occupy the mid-ground of the view, framed by nearby properties where mature gardens and outbuildings add to the settled rural nature of the view. The extensive mature woodlands of Binsted Wood form the background of the view with glimpses of the wider South Downs on the rising horizon. The view is representative of the view from St Mary's Church, users of Binsted Lane and nearby properties.

View west and north, along the fringes of Binsted Lane and a recently installed large detached property (Binsted Manor) set on the fringes of Binsted Wood that overlooks the open field to the south. This single large field, which forms the core area associated with the designed landscape of Binsted Park is enclosed by outgrown hedges and woodland, some of which is ancient woodland, on all sides forming an enclosed parcel of land in the foreground of the view. The view is representative of the users of Binsted Lane and adjacent property.

The view is heavily filtered and contained by dense adjacent woodland. During winter months views would extend slightly further through the woods but would remain largely contained. This extends to a canopy overhead that restricts views of the sky, giving an air of seclusion and remoteness. The view for users of the footpaths and bridleways within Binsted Woods and associated plantations, the majority of which is Ancient Woodland.

The view is contained by trees that have formed a canopy overhead creating a sense of a tunnel through the woodland. There is little traffic using the road and it represents an accessible point along which the sense of seclusion and remoteness of Binsted Woods can be experienced. The view is representative of the views experienced by users of Binsted Lane and those associated with the nearby property (Pinewoods) to the south west.





Views are contained within the immediate vicinity by dense adjacent woodland, much of which is Ancient Woodland. The canopy combines with the understorey planting to form a strong sense of enclosure, particularly during summer months. Representative of views experienced whilst walking the accessible footpaths and bridleways within Binsted Woods and associated with Tortington Common.





This view is experienced upon leaving the dense Ancient Woodland associated with Binsted Woods, this also marks the boundary of the SDNP – the expansive views experienced extend some distance to the south east towards the River Arun valley, beyond Tortington Priory. This view is representative of the views experienced by drivers and pedestrians using Tortington Lane. It is also representative of a single property on Priory Lane with some views to the south.

The view extends to the north and east, overlooking the edge of the River Arun floodplain from a slightly elevated position. In the mid distance is the planted boundary of the Tortington Priory, obscured behind mature trees on the southern boundary of the site. The mature trees and hedgerow along Tortington Lane can be seen to the left of the view, whilst Arundel Cathedral can be seen to the centre of the view, visible above the intervening tree lines. This view is typical of those experienced in fleeting views from the local road and along several footpaths that cross the more open, mainly arable landscape to the south of the Tortington Common woodland. It is also representative of a single property on Priory Lane with some views to the south.

The view north from Ford Road extends for a considerable distance, particularly to the north east. Arundel is visible in the far distance and the Tortington Priory complex and gently rising ground to the west limit broader views in this direction. The focus of the view is the open River Arun floodplain that extends eastwards, although the river itself is hidden beyond earth banks. There are distant views of the South Downs and the hill at Crossbush.





These transient views north from the Arun Valley railway line take in distant views of Arundel, the floodplain of the River Arun and the surrounding hills, the horizon formed by the southern fringes of the South Downs. Arundel Castle and Cathedral are the most notable and readily recognisable feature of the view. The River Arun in the foreground is hidden within the broader view by associated berms and flood defences however the flat landscape and lack of significant vegetation provides uninterrupted views north.

The view from the fringes of Littlehampton extend to the west and north – the distant hills of the South Downs forming the horizon. At the foot of the hills can be seen the fringes of Arundel, including the Cathedral and Castle with their distinctive profiles. Below this can be seen intermittent views of the River Arun floodplain, obscured by hedgerows and trees the linear pattern is a noticeable feature and in winter would be more readily observed. This view represents a number of views along the northern edge of Littlehampton from residential development.







Located within the gently rising landform of the Arun floodplain, the viewpoint captures the north westerly view of Arundel, the Cathedral and the Castle forming the most notable features within the view. The railway line forms the most immediate feature within the view, the low embankment forming an interim horizon, screening broader views of the River Arun beyond. The view is representative of the users of the footpath, and residential receptors.

The views experienced from the railway line form a set of sequential viewpoints that unfold as the train moves north east, approaching Arundel to the east of the town. The flat landscape that forms the River Arun floodplain is in marked contrast to the rising landform to the west, at the foot of which runs Ford Lane, approaching Arundel from the south.





The views from the banks of the River Arun, the view north along the river focuses all views towards the distinctive profiles of the Cathedral and the Castle. Beyond the town the wooded slopes rise sharply, giving way to the distant hills that form the South Downs National Park This view is representative of a series of views experienced by users of the right of way that runs parallel with the River Arun.

The view extends to the north and east, including the southern fringes of Arundel, and the adjacent meadows that form the immediate context to the town. The River Arun remains the most dominant feature within the view, whilst the Cathedral interrupts the horizon. The broader views of the South Downs are largely screened by the intervening horizon formed by the rooflines of Arundel, the Castle and intervening trees. The view is representative of those experienced by users of the local network of footpaths.

The view from the southern fringes of Arundel and overlooking the nearby floodplain. This viewpoint extends south east and extends to the opposite side of the valley, affording extensive views of the landscape and is representative of the local suburban roads and associated residential properties.


Overlooking the A27 from the southern slopes of Rewell Hill, this viewpoint has extensive and far reaching views from within the SDNP. Views of the A27 lie in the middle distance, having a backdrop of the extensive combined woodlands of Paine's Wood, Binsted Wood and Tortington Common and beyond the treed landscape associated with Binsted. This view is representative of those experienced by the users of the public rights of way network to the west of Arundel.

A view typical of those experienced from within the narrow and steeply sloping streets of Arundel, within the conservation area. This view reflects the historic views afforded to the Castle as a defendable location on the river. From this point it can be readily appreciated the wooded nature of the adjacent valley slopes that are in marked contrast to the valley floor, largely devoid of significant vegetation. The existing A27, partially screened by adjacent vegetation is visible in the foreground.

ARUNDEL RAILWAY STATION **EXISTING JUNCTION ON THE A27** View from the banks of the River Arun, views to the south look across the small riverside pasture towards the existing A27 as it crosses the river and rises to the east. The traffic on the A27 is clearly visible in summer and would be more obvious in the winter and in the absence of foliage. The view from Springhead Hill on the South Downs Way within the SDNP affords extensive views to the south, extending as far as the south coast with the hill slopes descending sharply into wooded cloughs and copses, gradually giving way to the woodland and plantations associated with the River Arun and surrounding farmland. The main feature within the view is Arundel Castle – its distinctive profile forming an easily recognisable feature within the landscape. This view is representative of views experienced by users of the extensive public rights of way network, the views representing a good opportunity to experience the relationship between the South Downs and the coastline.


