M25 junction 28 improvement scheme

Section 47 Planning Act 2008

Notice Publicising a Statement of Community Consultation

Highways England is planning to undertake an improvement scheme to M25 junction 28. Our proposals for the junction include the following main key features:

- Introduce a second exit road from M25 anti-clockwise carriageway onto new loop road
- Create new two-lane loop road with hard shoulder, for traffic traveling from M25 to A12 eastbound
- Provide new bridges to connect the new infrastructure into the existing network.

We intend to make an application to the Planning Inspectorate under section 37 of The Planning Act 2008 for a Development Consent Order to authorise construction of the scheme.

Before making our application we must produce a document called the Statement of Community Consultation setting out how we will consult the local community about our proposals. We also must make this statement available for inspection by the public and publish this notice stating where and when the statement can be inspected. We then must carry out consultation in accordance with the statement.

This notice contains a summary of the consultation details. However, full details of the consultation can be found in the Statement of Community Consultation. This can be viewed along with all our consultation materials, online at the project website www.highwaysengland.co.uk/m25j28 or at the following display locations from the start of our consultation on **03 December 2018** to the **28 January 2019**.
