

## A303 Sparkford to Ilchester Dualling Scheme Consultation questionnaire



Highways England is consulting on proposals to upgrade the A303 between Sparkford and Ilchester. This improvement is needed to relieve congestion and improve the safety performance of one of the busiest stretches of the A303/A358 route corridor that connects the south west to London and the south east.
